Cerner Updates

New Order Synonyms beginning March 21 at BUMCT/S include:

- Insert Gastrointestinal Tube can be ordered using “NG/OG”
- Insert Indwelling Urinary Catheter can be ordered using “Foley”
- RSP Blood Gas [cs] can be ordered using “ABG/VBG”
- RSP Ventilator can be ordered using “Vent”
- RSP Airway Clearance Therapy can be ordered using “Cough/Respiratory”

New System Synonyms beginning March 21 include:

- ED Transition to OB can be ordered using ED Transfer to OB
- ED Transition to OR/Outpatient can be ordered using ED Transfer to OR/Outpatient
- May Access Line can be ordered using Port/Line
- Bladder Volume Measurement can be ordered using Bladder Scan

Three new Respiratory Explorer Menu reports were added at the hospitals:

- Respiratory Charges Alpha
- Respiratory Charges
- Respiratory Productivity

A new Pediatric Outpatient Intake Form will be available on March 21. The form addresses the gap for pediatric outpatient intake documentation. It can be used in any pediatric outpatient department including pediatric oncology.
